Dear Ethan Grimes,

I am pleased to inform you that your Provost's Summer 2022 Student-Faculty Undergraduate Research proposal titled "Determination of Caffeine Content in Pre-Workout Supplements" has been approved for funding.

The Provost's Summer 2022 Student-Faculty Undergraduate Research Award provides a grant of \$1,200 paid to you, the student. The grant award will be made in two installments of \$600 each, one at the beginning of your project and the second and final payment when the project concludes. This grant also provides a \$300 payment to the faculty mentor. The grant award totals \$1,500.

You and your faculty mentor will determine the project schedule for summer 2022. You may begin your research project as early as May 16, 2022, but must conclude by August 31, 2022.

The Provost's Summer 2022 Student-Faculty Undergraduate Research Award requires that student awardees:

- 1) Participate in two or three mandatory awardee events that will include a virtual orientation workshop
- 2) Submit reflections after the orientation, at mid-summer, and as the project concludes
- 3) Submit by August 31, 2022, either a research paper or artistic project as the primary outcome of the summer research experience
- 4) Present the research or artistic project at the Fall 2022 Undergraduate Research Showcase (TBD)
