Dear Jennifer L. Hutnik,

I am pleased to inform you that your Provost's Student-Faculty Summer 2021 Undergraduate Research proposal titled "Optimization of pressure liquid extraction conditions in the extraction of propolis samples" has been approved for funding.

The Provost's Student-Faculty Summer 2021 Undergraduate Research Award provides a grant of \$1,000 paid to you, the student. The grant award will be made in two installments of \$500 each, one at the beginning of your project and the second and final payment when the project concludes. This grant also provides a \$150 payment to the faculty mentor's scholarly research account. The grant award totals \$1,150.

You and your faculty mentor will determine the project schedule for summer 2021. You may begin your research project as early as May 15, 2021 but must conclude by August 31, 2021.

The Provost's Student-Faculty Summer 2021 Undergraduate Research Award requirements:

- 1) Participate in two or three mandatory awardee events that will include a virtual orientation workshop
- 2) Submit reflections after the orientation, at mid-summer, and as the project concludes
- 3) Submit by August 31, 2021 either a research paper or artistic project as the primary outcome of your summer research experience
- 4) Present your research at the Fall 2021 Undergraduate Research Showcase (TBD)
