On behalf of President Friedman and Provost Sukhatme, we are pleased to inform you that you have been selected for the 2014-2015 student-faculty research program! *Congratulations!* There were many applications for this initiative, and only 27 faculty-student pairs were selected for this year.

You both will be working together on this proposed project which will run from September 2014 – May 2015. (The number of hours devoted to this project is completely up to the two of you.)

An honorarium of \$750 will be provided to faculty, paid around late September. You may use that money for yourself, supplies, or whatever else you deem appropriate. Student participants will receive a total stipend of \$500.

In April or early May of 2015, there will be a research showcase on each campus that will recognize all research projects (including those carried out through the academic year research program) via formal presentations and poster sessions. You and your student are invited to participate in the showcase to exhibit your work. In addition to the showcase, you are highly encouraged to submit your findings for possible publication, presentations, etc. Finally, we will ask that you prepare a short, year-end report on your student mentee's performance.

The undergraduate student-faculty website (www.pace.edu/ugresearch) will be updated to include information on all accepted projects and student-faculty teams. (Feel free to view it now for past projects and the most recent research showcase!)

Students will be asked to do the following: 1) submit four blog posts throughout the academic year about their experiences, which will be posted on the website; 2) attend four enrichment seminars throughout the year; and 3) write a mid-year and final report about your research experience.
