Dear Professor Mojica and Ms. Pace,

On behalf of President Friedman and Provost Sukhatme, we are pleased to inform you that you have been selected for the 2014 summer student-faculty research program! *Congratulations!* There were many applications for this initiative, and only 20 faculty-student pairs were selected for this year.

You both will be working together on this proposed project which will run from June – August 2014. (The number of hours devoted to this project is completely up to the two of you.)

An honorarium of \$750 will be provided to you, paid around late June. You may use that money for yourself, supplies, or whatever else you deem appropriate. The student will receive a total stipend of \$500.

In April or early May of 2014, there will be a research showcase on each campus that will recognize all research projects (including those carried out through the academic year research program) via formal presentations and poster sessions. You and your student are invited to participate in the showcase to exhibit your work. In addition to the showcase, you are highly encouraged to submit your findings for possible publication, presentations, etc. Finally, we will ask that you prepare a short, year-end report on your student mentee's performance.

The undergraduate student-faculty website (<u>www.pace.edu/ugresearch</u>) will be updated to include information on all accepted projects and student-faculty teams. (Feel free to view it now for past projects and the most recent research showcase!)

Students will be asked to do the following: 1) submit two blog posts throughout the summer about their experiences, which will be posted on the website; 2) read documents about scholarly research and research design/methodology; and 3) write a two-page report at the end of the summer.

Please sign and return one copy to this letter to Jonathan Hooker to indicate your acceptance of the award and your understanding of the terms by Monday, June 9th. (You can scan and email it if you prefer.)
